NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Intercollegiate Sailing Association in conjunction with the US Naval Academy.
- 1.2. This regatta shall be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), ICSA Procedural Rules, ICSA Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules, General Conditions for the ICSA Championships, 2021 Conditions for the ICSA Women's Dinghy National Championship, current Medical Guidance for ICSA Competition, and this Notice of Race, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.3. Procedural Rule 32 will be in effect.

2. PHOTOGRAPHY, CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

2.1. Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment or positioning equipment as specified by the Organizing Authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. All entrants must meet ICSA eligibility requirements and have qualified from their Conference Championship or been selected by their Conference according to the Conditions for the event.
- 3.2. Entry fee is \$500 per team payable online to ICSA.
- 3.3. Teams shall register as soon as possible after their Conference Championship and no later than May 5 by completing the online registration and paying all fees.

4. SCHEDULE AND NUMBER OF RACES

- 4.1. Report times and locations will be communicated to registered teams no later than May 14.
- 4.2. The regatta format for will be a single round robin as per ICSA PR 22 and the event conditions.

5. BOATS & EQUIPMENT

5.1. Collegiate Dinghy FJs and Z420s will be provided for competitors, who shall not modify any boat or cause them to be modified in any way.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available prior to the competitors' meeting and online at the event website.

7. RACING AREA

The Racing Area will be on the Annapolis Roads and the Severn River

8. COACHING

8.1. Coach boats will be provided to all teams.

9. SPECTATORS

- 9.1. All spectators shall remain 100 yards from competitors while racing. Spectators shall receive 1 warning upon entering the exclusion zone. The second entrance shall be cause for a protest by the OA or Race Committee against the affiliated team(s) under RRS 64.5.
- 9.2. Spectator boats shall not dock at any of the launching venues and spectators shall not enter any of the launching venues. This is considered a field of play and is only open to registered competitors and their coaches who have complied with the ICSA testing protocol.

10. TROPHIES

- 10.1. The Gerald C. Miller Trophy will be awarded to the first place team.
- 10.2. The New England Women's Trophy will be awarded to the second place team.
- 10.3. The Ann Campbell Trophy will be awarded to the third place team.
- 10.4. The Madeline Trophy will be awarded to the low point skipper of the 'A' Division.
- 10.5. The Judy Lawson Trophy will be awarded to the low point skipper of the 'B' Division.

11. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

12. PRACTICE EXCLUSION ZONE

12.1. Per ICSA PR 27 and depicted in Attachment A, the exclusion zone shall include the triangle formed by the Naval Academy Bridge, Hackett Point, and Tolly Point.
